ColliCare launches train number 3 between Scandinavia and Italy

- and continues its success in developing new transport possibilities by rail.

January 2024

1st February this year, ColliCare will double capacity for transporting cargo by rail between Sweden and Italy. The new train will run by roundtrip every week. The step from one to two departures per week gives the market a high class transport service between Scandinavia – Italy!

The wagons are conventional and can carry heavy and light pallets, and most other types of cargo. The transit time is very competitive, with 48 hours both ways. Competing with road transport, transit time is a clear advantage with using rail transport.

"This is a great opportunity for the Swedish / Scandinavian export industry to deliver their goods to the Italian market, with a fast lead time, environmental friendly & cost effective solution. You save up to 89% CO2e per FTL," says Allan Nielsen Managing director at ColliCare Logistics Sweden.

ColliCare already have two weekly departures by rail from Italy.

Route 1 – departure on Saturdays from Parma, Italy arriving Rolvsøy in Norway Monday morning.


Route 2 . departure from Falköping Sweden Tuesday morning, arriving in Cremona Italy on Thursday.
